SELECTMEN'S MEETING
MARCH 2, 2010

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

MISC: Selectmen discussed how to dispose of the old bunk house building. Also discussed general road repairs.

Mark said that the Selectmen of each town have to decide whether or not to allow licensed OHRV's to use Class VI roadways. The Board all agreed that this was allowable.

Mike said that he spoke to our town attorney concerning the approach to take in regards to increasing the assessed value for the flood control land should the warrant article pass. He said we should take a two step approach by first hiring an independent assessor to do a preliminary review and see where that goes. Then if that appears to have any bearing, documents should be researched.

Timber and gravel tax warrants were signed.

FIRE DEPT: Interim Chief Deanna Ford said that she found a reasonably priced generator for the new fire truck. Mike made a motion to appoint Deanna as our new Fire Chief. All agreed. She signed the appointment form and took the oath of office.

POLICE DEPT: Chief Kratz presented the Board with a summary of the calls this year which he said have increased.

WATER DEPT: Gerry Desrochers stopped in to have Mike sign an amendment to engineering services agreement for the water project.

With no further business to conduct, the meeting adjourned at 8:15pm.
