SELECTMEN'S MEETING  
MARCH 23, 2010

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

MISC: Mike was re-elected as Chairman of the Board. Mark took the oath of office.

Selectmen signed an excavation tax warrant and intents to excavate for R6-8 and R1-28.

Dave Hemeon was re-appointed as Water Commissioner per Gerry Desrochers request.

Selectmen discussed taking our town attorney and the assessor that he recommended for the Flood Control Land issue on a tour of the Old Village area. John spoke to Shaun Bresnahan about letting them drive through and determined that sometime next week would work.

LIBRARY: Selectmen met with Trustees, Gayle Seip and Julie Hunter to discuss the budget cuts. Mike said they are reducing the Library budget by \$7,000 in light of the town meeting vote to reduce the operating budget by \$37,000. This will bring their appropriation to \$21,000. All departments are being affected to some degree. Gayle said they may have to close the library one day a week.

FIRE DEPT: Chief Ford proposed cutting \$2,000 from the department's protective clothing line due to the budget reduction. She submitted the final purchase orders for the new truck expenses.

T/C, T/X: Desiree asked the Board for their opinion on her public notice listing new hours and dates closed. Selectmen felt it was adequate for its purpose. The office will now be closed to the public on Wednesday, but still be open the same schedule Tuesday evening, Thursday and Friday. She also received permission to contact the town attorney concerning a current use tax lien issue.
