SELECTMEN'S MEETING
APRIL 20, 2010

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

BOROUGH RD. BRIDGE: Mr. Alvin Coleman from A.J. Coleman & Son came in to discuss making payment for the construction thus far on the new bridge. A request for reimbursement from the State was made in February, but has not come through yet. Mr. Coleman impressed upon the Board the urgency of his situation as the bridge construction is well under way. Mike said the State has authorized the reimbursement, but we cannot pay him until that money is received. The Board asked Mr. Coleman to leave the meeting briefly to discuss the matter in private session. They then decided to start the process of establishing a line of credit or short term loan due to cash flow issues. We will give Mr. Coleman a portion of his request, but cannot make the whole payment until monies are received. Bristol has agreed to pay half of one of the smaller invoices to assist us temporarily.

FIRE DEPT: Chief Ford stopped in briefly to check in with the Board.

MISC: Selectmen discussed the assessing proposals received. They will schedule a meeting with Rod Wood to discuss his proposal next week if possible.

A building permit was approved for Charles Denningham of 19 Mountain View Dr. (V-32).

Melanie Waldvogel came in to be appointed as a Library Trustee.

TOWN CLERK: Desiree presented the Board with a wage agreement for her 2010 wages. She said since she is salaried, she is to be paid annually at the new rate from January to December referencing RSA 41:33. Selectmen will review the agreement and discuss next week.
