SELECTMEN'S MEETING
MAY 4, 2010

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

FIRE DEPT: Chief Ford stopped in briefly. No business to conduct.

POLICE DEPT: Chief Kratz stopped in briefly. He was asked to post hours open to the public.

RICHARD WRIGHT: Mr. Wright expressed concern about the snow plowing citing that there is always about 3 inches left on the road. He feels it is a safety issue. He also expressed concern about tree cutting and equipment safety. He stated that we could cut costs by using contractors. He also had to put in new boundaries due to the plow knocking them down.

MISC: Selectmen discussed "junk yards" and what constitutes them.

A building permit was issued to Rosa Akerley, 18 Bunker Hill Rd. (R11-21) and Ernest Burdick, 30 Highridge Rd. (R1-7-1-6).

2009 property tax abatement recommendations were reviewed and approved as follows:

8. Garth Szwed – R3-57 – Abated 29,432

PAULA MCDONOUGH: Paula asked if it was feasible to instigate curb side trash pick-up. She also expressed concern about school issue mainly hiring a new superintendent. The Board stated that they do not have any authority with these issues. They cannot tell the school how to conduct business unless it directly involves the town in some way.
