

TOWN OF HILL  
SELECTMEN'S MEETING  
MAY 11, 2010

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

STEVE PUNDERSON: At the Selectmen's request, Steve came in to talk about how to handle the fact that he has many junk cars on his property on Clough Rd. He admitted to having 75-80 vehicles on the lot. The State regulates and licenses junkyards. He said he is aware of the laws. He was also told that he could not infringe on the current use area of his land. Discussed either cleaning up the vehicles or becoming a licensed junkyard. Steve decided that he would prefer to remove them and asked if the Board could give him the summer to take care of it, which they agreed to do.

ROAD AGENT: Dean said he hasn't heard anything about the new truck yet, but expects delivery to be around June. He has contacted Ray Judd about the work on Cass Mill. Also discussed moving large rocks on Borough Rd. He has moved some of them.

BOROUGH RD. BRIDGE: Don, a Selectman from Bristol, came in to discuss additional work involving the road and guardrails that they would like to pursue. The Selectmen share his concerns and agree it was ok to explore the idea. Dubois & King will get quotes. He also said that although Bristol was willing to help with some recent cash flow issues regarding the Bridge project, the State did not want to involve them in the funding aspect as Hill is the one they signed the contract with.

POLICE DEPT: Chief Kratz stopped by briefly. He submitted a list of the calls for service and a revised fine schedule for town ordinances. He also said that they will be enforcing no parking in front of the Fire Station. He plans to offer public hours on Sundays from 10am to 1pm.

GEORGE ROBIE: George came in to discuss a right-of-way issue involving a town owned lot on Dearborn Rd. (R6-27). More research needs to be done prior to pursuing it.

MISC: Selectmen signed an agreement with Frankin Savings Bank for a line of credit in the amount of \$200,000 to help with cash flow.

An intent to cut was signed for Raymond Robie, Jr. (R11-5). Veteran's Credits were approved.

Current use applications were approved as follows: Martin Judd (R6-37, R6-37-2), David Bonneau (R13-40), Richard Vincent (R11-2), James Dombroski (R10-28), William O'Connor (R1-53, R1-54), Christina Schaefer (R1-38-1).

A Current Use change tax was assessed for: (R4-22, R13-18-1, R10-5-1).

Meeting adjourned at 8:30pm.
