MAY 25, 2010

HIGHWAY DEPT: Dean stopped in and spoke about removing the large boulders on Borough Rd. He cannot move some of them so they will have to be split.

BOROUGH RD. BRIDGE: Mr. Coleman stopped by to see the status of payment for the bridge construction. He was told to stop in on Thursday for the check. We still have not received reimbursement from the State. They also discussed the meeting that was held Monday about the added guardrail etc.

MIKE & MARYANN MOSES: Mr. & Mrs. Moses stopped in to file a complaint about the construction vehicles using Bootjack Rd. to and from the gravel pit. They submitted photos of the dust that is being created by the heavy traffic constantly using the road throughout the day. There is a resident who is ill living on that road and they expressed concern about her health due to this issue. There was an agreement to keep the dust down on that road with the previous users of the pit. They said they spoke to Edmunds about it, but not enough has been done to control the problem. The Selectmen will ask him to come in and discuss the issue.

POLICE DEPT: Chief Kratz stopped in briefly. He said that one of the officers hit a dog and he will get an estimate for the damage to the cruiser.

NON PUBLIC SESSION: Selectmen entered into nps at 7:10pm to meet with a potential assistance client. Nps ended at 7:30pm.

MISC: Selectmen approved a building permit for Mark Dow (R1-6).
An intent to cut for Albert Moriarty was signed (R8-20, R8-21).

With no further business to conduct, the meeting adjourned at 8:20pm.
