**NEW BUSINESS:**

**Ferrin Street Extension** – residents from Ferrin St came to request that the water main for the water system be extended all the way to the end of Ferrin Street. (See attached petition) The residents wish to have this done at little to no cost to them. The Commissioners stated the current regulations require that such requests be in writing, a survey is to be done to determine costs, a warrant article would have to be presented at town meeting for approval, applicants must deposit money for estimated costs, and that costs are to be at the applicant expense.

Conversation took place as to whether grant money could be used towards such a project. The commissioners will take this under consideration as the current Lines, Tank and Meter project activities slow down.

**Shut Off procedures** – The commissioners directed Desiree L. Mahurin, Tax Collector to start shut off proceedings for delinquent accounts.

**DES Grant Funding** – grant funds are available for material and installation of generators at water stations in cooperation with Homeland Security. The Commissioners all agreed to have Commissioner Desrochers move forward in the application process.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**L-T-M Project** – Approximately 50% of all meters have been installed as of this date. There are a few residences with plumbing issues and 3-5 residences that require a pit.

Reviewed Contract 3 (water tank rehab) documents and plans with Andy Sharpe.
